REIGATE SQUASH CLUB 2017 TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Courts have been scheduled for every match at the times shown on the draw sheets.
- 2. If, with the agreement of your opponent, you wish to play your match at another mutually acceptable time this may be done subject to a court being available. Matches may also be played in advance of the tournament formally starting on 18th March. If you wish to change the date or time of your match please book a court in the normal fashion and e-mail either Lisa Pinggera or myself to confirm which court booking is not being used and the court fee will be refunded and it will allow us to free up courts that are not being used such that other members can utilise them.
- 3. Results are to be submitted through the MyCourts booking system, any results noted on the draw sheets on the notice board are for reference only. It is the winners responsibility for submitting the match result and if a result is not submitted by the date of the next fixture the person failing to submit a result could be disqualified.
- 3. All matches are the best of $\underline{\it FIVE}$ games in all rounds except for the MIXED HANDICAP best of three games in 1st and 2nd rounds,
- best of five games from 3rd round onwards (check on draw sheets).
- 4. All matches use traditional scoring to 9 except for the OPEN, MIXED HANDICAP, PLATE and DOUBLES which all are:
- American scoring (ie point per rally irrespective of who served) up to 11.
- If reach 10-10 then must be 2 clear points ahead to win the game.
- 5. HANDICAP:
 - -Handicaps may, if necessary be altered in the early rounds at the discretion of the organiser.
 - -2 minus handicaps must be netted up to zero and 2 plus handicaps down to zero

eq: -20 playing -12 would start at -8 / 0

- 5 playing +3 would start at -5 / 3
- +3 playing +8 would start at 0/5
- 6. OPEN PLATE for 1st Round losers and 2nd round losers who had a bye in the 1st round. Please put your name on the list if you want to enter – closing date is Monday 27th March! You will not be automatically entered.
- 7. DOUBLES Best of 5 games in all rounds with American scoring up to 11.

Only 1 serve allowed + Strokes may be awarded (marked matches only).

Players are reminded of the SRA recommendations on eye protection for doubles –approved eye wear is sold in the bar (limited supply only). The player identified as being the Captain of each doubles pair (as per the attached sheet) is the person from each pair that is responsible for submitting the result.

8. Markers will be provided on Finals' night.
